Organise events and delegate duties to helpers and volunteers. Be ultimately responsible for the financial decisions and actions of the Committee.

Secretary

Working alongside the chair you will help plan the agenda for meetings and write up the minutes. You will be responsible for obtaining licences and ensuring The Friends work in line with its constitution. You will also help with events, respond to enquiries and order equipment and materials as needed.

In September, we will also need someone to take on updating the website, writing The Friends newsletter and designing posters to promote events. Training and support will be given, if needed.
