FRIENDS COMMITTEE TO STEP DOWN!

After three years of running the Friends, in September, the current Co-Chairs, Treasurer and Secretary will all step down from their roles.

At the moment, we have one person interested in potentially taking on the Treasurer's Role, but without people to take on the Chair and Secretary roles the Friends PTA will legally be unable to continue and as such it will close in September,

If this happens, this will mean an end to events and fun activities for the children as well as much needed additional and, more frequently now, fundamental equipment and support for the school.

Here is some information on what is required for each role:

Chair

Oversee and run the Friends meetings, held twice a term. Along with the rest of the committee, decide what events will be run and liaise with the Head Teacher and any other relevant staff. Organise events and delegate duties to helpers and volunteers. Be ultimately responsible for the financial decisions and actions of the Committee.

Secretary

Working alongside the chair you will help plan the agenda for meetings and write up the minutes. You will be responsible for obtaining licences and ensuring The Friends work in line with its constitution. You will also help with events, respond to enquiries and order equipment and materials as needed.

Treasurer

Maintain financial records, keep accurate and up-to-date records of income, expenses, and bank transactions. Manage the bank account, ensure all transactions are recorded and reconciled with statements. Track income & expenses, monitor funds raised through events, donations, and grants, and oversee spending.

We also need someone or some people to take on updating the website, writing The Friends newsletter and designing posters to promote events. Training and support will be given, if needed.

Working on the committee, can be a great way to meet new people in the School and can also help to develop new skills that you may need, if you are looking to get back into work. Please email for more information.
